D360 Audio Interface (Switched)



The D360-AIS gives the Operator a tool to select which channel to listen to or feedback to the patient.

The D360-AIS plugs into the Signal Channel Output socket on the rear of the D360 and the LINE-IN socket of a PC.

The PC (assuming a good audio card) is used to control the frequency response (tone - Bass & Treble) as well as volume.

The D360-AIS also has a volume control.

The D360-AIS contains audio-isolation transformers to remove the possibility of mains-frequency "hum" on the monitored signal.

The D360-AIS is supplied (as shown above) with an attached lead to the D360 Signal Output socket as well as a 3.5mm stereo lead to the PC "LINE-IN" socket (often coloured - Blue).
